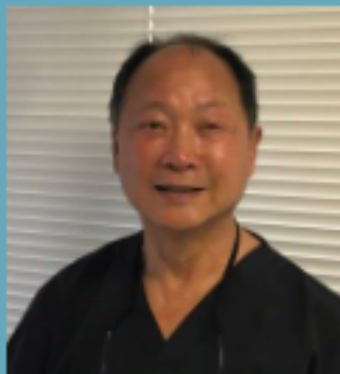




DENTISTRY ON PARKSIDE NEWS BITES
