At that time we did a large number of phone consultations, prescriptions and treated emergency patients which met the criteria under the New Zealand Dental Council standard.

At level 1 we are back to our regular PPE (personal protective equipment). We would like to assure that all our staff are fully trained with up to date infection control policies put out by the New Zealand Dental Association and the New Zealand Dental Council.

We are happy to answer any questions you have about our equipment processing and infection control procedures. We have instrument tracking in place to ensure that all our critical items have been processed to the standard.
